By submitting a bid for this project you are agreeing to provide and install a complete working system for all the necessary equipment, components, and misc. items that are shown on the drawings, part of the contract documents and specifications, and this addendum.

1. Prevailing Wage Rates, Section 00 73 52, have been updated. Proposal must include latest prevailing wage rates which are dated June 10, 2011 (Heavy/Highway). These updated wage rates can be viewed at the following website location:

2. Please note the following updates to the Technical Specification “Painting of Metal Surfaces, Section 09 90 00”.

3.03 Preparation of Surfaces, Item B.1 should read as follows:

1. Remove weld splatter and other projections. Grind sharp edges to a minimum radius of 1/8-inch. Grind rough welds smooth. Surfaces shall be smooth and contoured. Grinding shall be in accordance with SSPC Surface preparation Commentary.

4.01 Coating Schedule, Item A.1, A.2 and A.3 should read as follows:

- A. The following surfaces shall have the types of paint below applied at the dry film thickness (DFT) in mils per coat noted. All surface preparation requirements to be in accordance with manufacturer’s Product Data Sheets.
 1. Exterior non-submerged ferrous metals
 - a. Surface preparation: SSPC-SP6.
 - b. 1 coat Carboguard 60 or Macropoxy 646 on properly prepared unprimed metal for touch up (3.0 – 5.0 DFT).
 - c. 1 coat Carboguard 60 or Macropoxy 646 (3.0 – 5.0 DFT).
 - d. 1 coat Carbothane 133 LH, Acrolon 218HS, or Hi-Solids Polyurethane (3.0 – 5.0 DFT).
 2. Submerged ferrous metals and ferrous metals subject to submersion or splashing.
 - a. Surface preparation: SSPC-SP10.
 - b. 2 coats Bitumastic 300M or Hi-Mil Sher-Tar (Total DFT 16 – 20 mil).
 3. Plastic piping and, where scheduled to be painted, plastic components.
 - a. Scarify plastic pipe surfaces.
 - b. 1 coat Carboguard 60 or Macropoxy 646 (3.0 – 5.0 DFT).
 - c. 1 coat Carbothane 133 LH, Acrolon 218HS, or Hi-Solids Polyurethane (3.0 – 5.0 DFT).
3. Please note the following changes/clarifications addressed at the pre-bid meeting on June 13, 2011 at 1:00 p.m. at the Village of Eldorado’s Wastewater Treatment Plant:
 1. Bar Screen (Alternate #2):

The existing bar screen is to be removed and replaced with a new bar screen as part of Alternate #2. The new bar screen is to be an identical replicate of the existing (height, width, bar spacing, support members, etc.) and is to be constructed of A-36 steel. The bar screen is to be properly coated according to the paint manufacturer’s written specifications. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to field verify the exact bar screen dimensions. Please note, the engineer will not allow the bar screen construction material to vary from the specifications above.

2. Constant Head Flow Splitter Box:

Please note, the constant head flow splitter box is to be refurbished according to the original engineering scope of work. The scope of work covers the refurbishing of the entire ± 7'-6" x 2'-6" constant head flow splitter box per the original engineering scope of work report.

3. Draining of the Tank:

The contractor's responsibilities are to begin with the cleaning of the south clarifier, south aeration tank and surge tank after the Village of Eldorado has drained and removed the sludge within a maximum sludge level of 1" remaining in the bottom of the tank as part of the base bid.

Please note, Alternate #3 has been added to the Bid Items List and is to include the cost to remove the sludge from the south clarifier, south aeration tank, and surge tank. Alternate #3 is requesting the cost per cubic foot (ft³) for the contractor to remove the sludge in the above tanks after the Village of Eldorado has removed all the water off the top of the sludge. The estimated sludge volume to be bid is: 1600 ft³ of sludge for the south clarifier and aeration tank and 1050 ft³ for the surge tank. The exact volume of sludge will be field determined by the contractor, engineer, and owner during the removal of the sludge and the contractor's compensation will be adjusted according to the cost per cubic foot (ft³) provided on the bid form. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to properly dispose of the sludge according to all applicable laws.

4. Water re-routing during Surge Tank Refurbishing:

As discussed during the pre-bid meeting, the Village of Eldorado will re-direct the influent water into the plant from the existing lift station prior to beginning the refurbishing of the surge tank. When the Village has redirected the influent water, the surge tank shall be drained and all sludge is to be removed by the appropriate party (depending if Alternate #3 is accepted). Once the sludge is removed the contractor shall begin refurbishing the surge tank according to the procedure discussed in the original engineering scope of work report.

5. Aeration Diffuser Drop Refurbishing:
Please pay careful attention to this section...the contents of this section has been modified from the pre-bid meeting discussions. The Village of Eldorado shall be responsible for the removal and replacement of the aeration membrane only. The aeration drop lines are to be cleaned and properly prepared following the paint manufacturers written specifications and all applicable standards by the contractor. The drop lines are to be painted according to the paint manufacturers written specifications and in accordance with the “Painting of Metal Surfaces, Section 09 90 00” section of the technical specifications supplied by the engineer. If the contractor feels it is necessary to remove the aeration drop lines to complete the proposed work it will be their responsibility to remove and re-install the aeration drop lines. The Village of Eldorado will install all new aeration membranes after the aeration drop lines are completely refurbished by the contractor.
4. A new Bid Form, Section 00 41 43, is attached which is to replace the Bid Form from the original contract documents. This new Bid Form includes Alternate No. 3.
5. Engineer’s Estimate for Alternate No. 3 is \$4,000.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour Regional Office for the area in which the survey was conducted because those Regional Offices have responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.
