

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by the Greenville City Schools, at the Superintendent's Office, Memorial Hall, 215 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331 until 2:00 p.m. (local time) on Monday, July 19, 2010 for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Greenville City Schools Memorial Hall Masonry Restoration – Part A “Temporary Shoring”** Project. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The work for which proposals are invited is located at Greenville City Schools, Memorial Hall, 215 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio. The work shall include providing and installing temporary shoring for the north side of Memorial Hall, 215 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331.

A **pre-bid meeting** will be held on Tuesday, July 13, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. at the job site (Greenville City Schools, Memorial Hall, 215 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331).

Contract documents including specifications may be examined or obtained at the office of the Consulting Engineer, Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$35.00. An additional non-refundable handling charge of \$10.00 per set is required, if documents are to be shipped. Checks shall be made payable to Mote & Associates, Inc. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have obtained Contract Documents (including plans and specifications) from Mote & Associates, Inc. and have been registered as a planholder.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on the projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires that all work be completed no later than Friday, August 27, 2010. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

The Greenville City Schools reserve the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.

The engineer's construction cost estimate for this work is \$75,000.
