

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received at the Village of New Bremen, P. O. Box 27, 214 North Washington Street, New Bremen, Ohio 45869 until 11:00 A.M. (local time), on Tuesday, May 31, 2011, for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Bear Drive Reconstruction**. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The work for which proposals are invited includes the reconstruction of  $\pm 1570$  ft. of existing street in the Teton Subdivision. The northern  $\pm 600$  ft. of Bear Drive is included in the base bid. An alternate bid encompasses the remaining work on Bear Drive. The project will include storm drainage improvements, new asphalt street, new curb and gutter, new driveway approaches and partial sidewalk replacements. The project also includes a second alternate bid for  $\pm 800$  ft. of resurfacing on Fox and Cardinal Streets.

Contract Documents including Specifications and the Plans may be examined at the office of the Village of New Bremen, 214 North Washington Street, New Bremen Ohio 45869 or at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. Contract Documents including Specifications and Plans may be purchased through the printer, ARC Reprographics Co., by calling 1-800-966-2260. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of approximately \$65.00 plus tax. An additional non-refundable handling charge will be required if documents are to be shipped. Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have purchased Contract Documents (including Plans and Specifications) and have been registered as a planholder.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on the projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than Friday, October 28, 2011. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Auglaize County and the Village of New Bremen as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, 614-644-2239.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

The Village of New Bremen reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
