

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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Sealed bids will be received at the Village of New Bremen, P. O. Box 27, 214 North Washington Street, New Bremen, Ohio 45869 until 11:00 A.M. (local time), on Thursday, September 3, 2009, for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the projects known as **Contract A - Alley Reconstruction 2009 and Contract B - Rummel Creek and Melrose Place Resurfacing**. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders may submit a bid for Contract A or for Contract B or may offer a combination bid for both contracts. The work for which proposals are invited includes: Contract A - the reconstruction of three 10ø wide asphalt alleys for a total length of ±2800ø including storm drainage as well as a new ±560øó 8ø sanitary sewer and all appurtenances and Contract B ó the milling and resurfacing of ±2300ø of existing asphalt streets in the Pioneer Subdivision.

Contract Documents including specifications and the plans may be examined at the office of the Village of New Bremen, 214 North Washington Street, New Bremen Ohio 45869 or obtained at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$40.00. An additional non-refundable handling charge of \$10.00 per set is required, if documents are to be shipped.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on the projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than Friday, November 20, 2009.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Auglaize County and the Village of New Bremen as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, 614-644-2239.

The Village of New Bremen reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
